



# Adopt a Career Cat

## “Alternative Placement”

The Placer SPCA is looking for cat lovers who have secure outdoor structures and are interested in adopting Career Cats. These cats are best suited for:

### Placement Options:

- Barns
- Storage areas
- Shops/storefronts
- Supply yards & more!
- Vineyards

### Adoption Process:

We will do our best to match up a cat with your particular circumstance. Due to the nature of the program, we may not have suitable cats available immediately. If a suitable cat is not available at the time of your initial request, we will add you to a waiting list and contact you when we have a cat that fits your needs. You will be asked to sign an adoption contract prior to finalizing your adoption. The adoption fee is waived!

### Prior to adoption all cats in the Career Cat Program have been:

- Spayed or neutered
- Microchipped
- Rabies and FVRCP vaccinated
- Tested FELV/ FIV negative
- Examined and treated for ear mites

### As a caretaker, you are required to provide:

- The ability and commitment to keep the cat(s) confined to an enclosed area or exercise pen with a secure top to prevent escape for at least four weeks. *This allows the cat(s) to become acclimated to the new environment before release so they stay on the property.*
- A warm, secure, dry barn or building in which the cat(s) can live.
- A clean litter box that is scooped and/or cleaned daily while confined.
- A constant supply of dry food and fresh water.
- A safe area, in which you can monitor the overall well-being of the cat(s).
- The willingness to trap and provide veterinary care as needed.
