This program meets steps 1-4 of the Pet’s Badge requirements. Pets Badge not included.

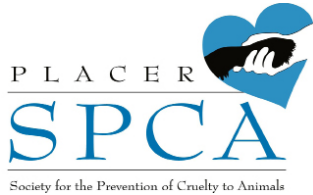
- What three different variety of pets need
