# Puparassi Alert! Hamlet's Happy Tail

Hamlet has one of the coolest 'happy tails' since leaving shelter life behind. As a matter of fact, it's as if he was destined for fame; evident by his keen fashion sense, contest wins, and his very own Instagram account with over 22,100 followers (and counting)!

We're some of Hamlet's biggest 'puparazzi' and it's been pawsome to see how far he's come since leaving Placer SPCA in 2020. Hamlet, who was once homeless, is now living his best life with his wonderful dog mom, April. You'll want to read on as we caught up with April to learn more about Hamlet's fun-filled life after adoption.



April: I had seen Hamlet's sweet face on Placer SPCA's website and despite being adamant that I would 'never get another dog' after losing my rescue dog, Mylee — I knew instantly that he was meant to be my dog. I made an appointment to meet him as soon as the shelter opened and adopted him the next day.



April: My best friend suggested I make Hammy an Instagram account to help keep my mind off having lost Mylee. I created it thinking that no one would follow some random dog, but almost instantly, he had hundreds... and then thousands of followers. In the same month that we made his Instagram account, we entered an America's Favorite Pet competition and out of thousands and thousands of dogs, Hamlet took third place and was featured in "Dogster Magazine".

PSPCA: Tell us how Hamlet got a stuffed animal created that looks just like him. April: Hamlet was entered into the Pibborafi Rescue Heroes contest, where three rescue dogs would be chosen to be made into a stuffie. It was in the voter's hands, and they chose Hammy as one of the winners! His stuffed animal is still up for sale on the Pibborafi® website and 30% of net proceeds goes to a rescue helping bully dogs in dire need of medical treatment and placement.



April: I can't give out too many secrets, but he always has a big surprise waiting around the corner! Follow his Instagram (@hamlet\_the\_rescue) to keep up with what he has in store next (and to see what he's wearing)!

Hamlet is a huge fan of 'pupcups' and you may find him at a local coffee shop (that's where one our volunteers ran into him and learned about his stuffie contest). Another fun fact, Hamlet picks his own outfits! April says, "I empty his bin of clothes and hats and say 'pick a shirt' and 'pick a hat' and he will nudge one of each!" 
