Make the Most of Your Year-End Giving

Making a gift at year-end can be such a meaningful and thoughtful way to show your love of animals. There are tax-savvy strategies that may help your giving go even further this year. Consider these options:

- 🐾 Giving gifts of appreciated stock may help you avoid capital gains taxes on appreciated assets held for over one year.
- 🐾 Optimize giving from your Donor-Advised Fund (DAF). You can recommend grant funding to qualified charities as you wish, plus add to your DAF as often as you like (*dependent on DAF*).
- 🐾 A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) from your IRA may be used to satisfy your required minimum distribution and help keep your taxable income lower.
- 🐾 Consider "bunching" – grouping two or more years of charitable gifts into a single year to exceed the itemization threshold.

As always, please consult your tax, legal, or financial professional for guidance on what charitable giving strategy is right for you.
